

IT Committee Meeting

At 2:00 p.m. Chair Ron Delcamp called the meeting to order.

Internet Update & Necessary Hardware From Frontier Representative Bryant Bloedorn

Mr. Bloedorn advised the Committee that Frontier has better options, reviewed the current monthly invoicing from Frontier. He also stated fiber is less than 1,700 feet away, and there is availability for the City to upgrade to a better internet system. Due to the outdated Nortel telephone system, it makes sense to upgrade the phones which will provide many more service opportunities for the City with a new phone system.

Numerous questions were asked by committee members, Marianna Groth and the IT representatives. Marianna did not want the City to have a telephone system that would not be able to be fixed without costs from Frontier.

Member Wuolle was concerned with the fact that if the system went down, the phones would be down also. Even though users could switch phone calls to go to a cell phone, not all employees have city cell phones.

It was the consensus of the committee and guests that the proposal may be a good option for the City. Mr. Bloedorn will get more information to the City upon getting data from City Clerk Nila Jurkovich.
