Contractors and outside workers having work in the cemetery must make known their business to the City of Kellogg Clerk's office and receive written permission 48 hours before any work is commenced.

Hold Harmless:

The City of Kellogg will at all times exercise diligence and reasonable care in the protection of the rights and property of the space owners and visitors of the Cemetery, but shall not be liable for any damage and future damage that may occur as a result of the outside contractors/workers work done in the Cemetery. Any damage to cemetery property will be corrected by those individuals at their sole cost.

Applicant, for itself and all persons and entities acting under, through, or on the behalf of applicant, shall indemnify and hold harmless the City for any and all liability and damages for personal injuries, property damage or for loss of life or property resulting from, or in any way connected with, the condition or the use of the premises covered by this agreement, or any means of ingress thereto or egress therefrom, except liability for personal injuries, property damages or loss of life or property caused solely by the negligence or other fault of the City.

Holders of rights to bury in lots and niches will instruct those outside contractors/workers to exercise caution not to damage adjoining or nearby graves or monuments of others. Any damage to cemetery property will be corrected by those individuals at their sole cost.
